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Class Description

From the Utah Core State Standards for Mathematics: In Secondary I, students will formalize and extend mathematical understanding. Students will deepen comprehension of linear relationships. They will compare and contrast with exponential phenomena. Students will use properties and theorems to extend understanding of congruent figures. Additionally, students will blend algebraic and geometric ideas.

Objectives

- 1. Students will be able to apply understanding of math concepts learned in Secondary I to real world applications.
- 2. Students will be prepared to achieve success in Secondary 2 in high school.

Utah has developed a Core Curriculum which outlines specific standards for student learning. This includes ideas, concepts, and skills which provide a foundation on which subsequent learning may be built.

Citizenship Grade Scale:

Citizenship grades are given on the basis of the entire term and not upon a single incident. The attendance and tardy policy of the school and district are followed. Behavior should reflect respect, responsibility, and trust. The three components that citizenship will be graded upon will be tardies, unexcused absences, and behavior.
